## MATERIALS

## Yarn:

Fingering weight ( $50 \mathrm{gr} / 125 \mathrm{~m}$ ) cotton yarn in the skin color of your choice, green, yellow, blue and pink.
For my sample I use Scheepjes Catona in the colorways: Shell (255), Silver Green (402), Primrose (522), Cyan (396) and Marshmallow (518).

## Crochet Hook:

## 2.5 mm crochet hook.

## Notions:

Fiberfill for stuffing, 8 mm safety eyes, pins, tapestry needle, stitch marker, scissors.

## GAUGE

26 stitches and 27 rows in single crochet worked in the round, with 2.5 mm crochet hook $=10 \mathrm{~cm}$.

Gauge is not important for this project. However, changes might affect the finished measurements and the safety eyes size.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approx. 19 cm (7.5 in) tall.

## ABBREVIATIONS

This pattern is written in US terminology.

## mc: magic circle

ch: chain
sc: single crochet
inc: increase 1 st ( 2 sc in the same st)
dec: decrease 1 st (single crochet 2 sts together)
hdc: half double crochet
blo: back loops only
sl st: slip stitch
st(s): stitch(es)
rnds: rounds
\{...\}: repeat enclosed instructions the amount of times indicated
[...]: the enclosed instructions are worked in the same st
(...): total number of sts of the round and/or additional information

Unless otherwise noted, all the individual parts of the pattern are worked in continuous rounds. Use a stitch marker to keep track of your rounds.


## Body

Use green and skin color yarn.

Start with green yarn. Stuff the body as you go.

Round 1: In mc work 6 sc. (6 sts).
Rounds 2-4: 3 rnds. 6 sc. ( 6 sts).
Round 5: $\{2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}\} 2$ times. (8 sts).
Rounds 6-7: 2 rnds. 8 sc. (8 sts).
Round 8: $\{3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}\} 2$ times. ( 10 sts ).
Rounds 9-10: 2 rnds. 10 sc. ( 10 sts ).
Round 11: $\{4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}\} 2$ times. (12 sts).
Rounds 12-13: 2 rnds. 12 sc. (12 sts).
Round 14: $\{1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}\} 6$ times. ( 18 sts ).
Rounds 15-16: 2 rnds. 18 sc. (18 sts).
Round 17: $\{2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}\} 6$ times. (24 sts).

Rounds 18-20: 3 rnds. 24 sc. (24 sts).
Round 21: $\{3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}\} 6$ times. (30 sts).
Rounds 22-31: 10 rnds. 30 sc. ( 30 sts).
Round 32: $\{13 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}\} 2$ times. (28 sts).
Change to skin color yarn.
Round 33: 28 sc blo (28 sts).
Round 34: $\{5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}\} 4$ times. ( 24 sts ).
Rounds 35-42: 8 rnds. 24 sc. ( 24 sts).
Round 43: $\{2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}\} 6$ times. ( 18 sts ).
Round 44: $\{1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}\} 6$ times. (12 sts).
Round 45: \{1 sc, dec 4 times. (8 sts).
Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. Pic1.

## Head

Use skin color yarn.
Round 1: In mc work 6 sc. (6 sts).
Round 2: 6 inc. (12 sts).
Round 3: $\{1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}\} 6$ times. (18 sts).
Round 4: \{2 sc, inc\} 6 times. ( 24 sts ).
Round 5: $\{3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}\} 6$ times. ( 30 sts ).
Round 6: $\{4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}\} 6$ times. ( 36 sts ).
Rounds 7-11: 5 rnds. 36 sc. ( 36 sts).
Round 12: $11 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{inc}, 5 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{inc}, 14 \mathrm{sc}$. (42 sts).

Rounds 13-15: 3 rnds. 42 sc. ( 42 sts).
Round 16: $\{5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}\} 6$ times. ( 36 sts ).
Round 17: $\{4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}\} 6$ times. (30 sts).
Insert the safety eyes between rnds 10 and 11, on the same side as the increases, approx. 8 sts apart.

Round 18: $\{3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}\} 6$ times. (24 sts).
Stuff the head with fiberfill.
Round 19: $\{2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}\} 6$ times. (18 sts).
Round 20: $\{1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}\} 6$ times. (12 sts).
Round 21: $\{1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}\} 4$ times. (8 sts).
Fasten off and weave in the ends.
Use skin color yarn to embroider the nose. Pic2.

## Arms

Use skin color yarn. Make two.
Stuff lightly only the hands with fiberfill.
Round 1: In mc work 6 sc. (6 sts).
Round 2: $\{2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}\} 2$ times. (8 sts).
Rounds 3-17: 15 rnds. 8 sc. (8 sts).
Flatten the top and work 3 sc through both layers to close the opening.

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. Pic3.



## Fins

Use yellow yarn. Make two.
The fins are worked in rows.
Row 1: Ch 15, turn. Starting the second ch from hook, work: 12 sc , dec. ( 13 sts ).

Row 2: Ch 1, turn. Dec, 10 sc. (11 sts).
Row 3: Ch 1, turn. 9 sc, dec. (10 sts).
Row 4: Ch 1, turn. Dec, 7 sc. (8 sts).
Row 5: Ch 1, turn. 6 sc, dec. (7 sts).
Row 6: Ch 1, turn. Dec, 4 sc. (5 sts).
Row 7: Ch 1, turn. 3 sc, dec. (4 sts).
Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. Pic4.


## Hair

Use pink yarn.
Round 1: In mc work 6 sc. (6 sts).
Round 2: 6 inc. (12 sts).
Round 3: $\{1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}\} 6$ times. ( 18 sts ).
Round 4: \{2 sc, inc\} 6 times. ( 24 sts ).
Round 5: \{Ch 18, turn. Starting at the second ch from hook, work: $17 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next st\} 2 times. \{Ch 9, turn. Starting at the second ch from hook, work: $8 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next st\} 4 times. \{Ch 18, turn. Starting at the second ch from hook, work: $17 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next st\} 2 times. \{Ch 31, turn. Starting at the second ch from hook, work: 30 sc, 1 sc in the next st\} 15 times. Ch 31, turn. Starting at the second ch from hook, work: 30 sc. Close the round with a sl st in the first st.

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. Pic5.


## Shells

Use blue yarn. Make two.
Round 1: In mc work \{1 hdc, 1 sl st $\}$ times. Close the round with a sl st in the first st. (5 sts).

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. Pic6.

## Assembly

- Sew the head to the body. Pic7.
- Sew the arms on the sides of the body. Pic8.
- Sew the shells on the body. Pic9.
- Sew the fins on the bottom sides of the body (tail). Pic10.
- Sew the hair on the head. Pic11.
- Weave in any remaining ends.



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
